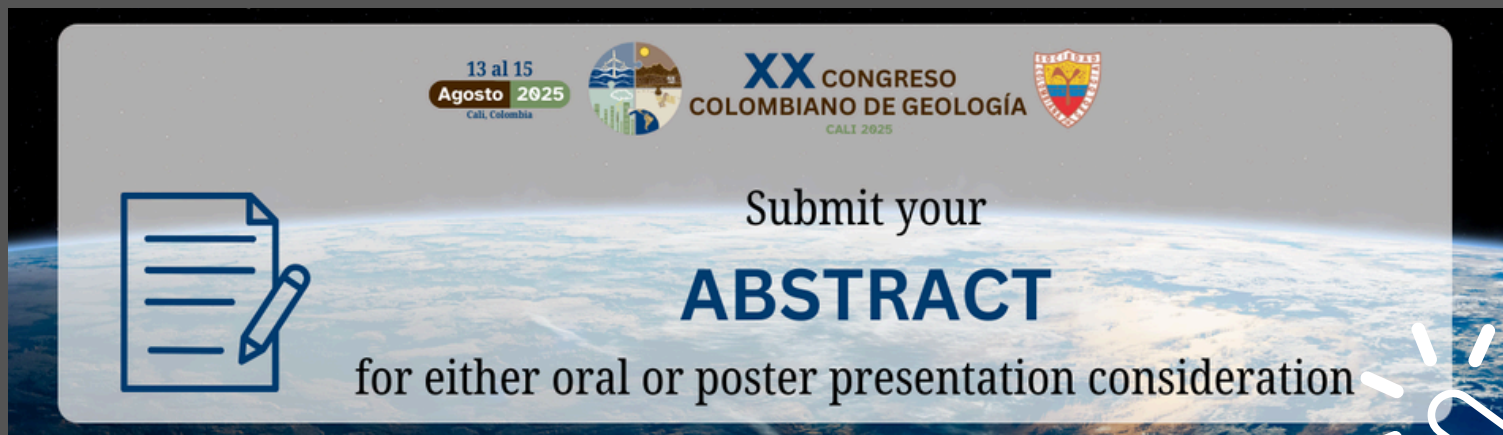

The **CCG2025** Organizing Committee invites you to submit **abstracts for either oral or poster presentation** consideration at the **Colombian Geological Congress (CCG)** on its 20th version.

Abstract submission closes on **31 March 2025 at 11:59PM** Colombian Time (UTC/GMT-5).

To submit an abstract, you must **fill out the online submission form** available on the official Congress website (or by clicking on the image above - only on the PDF version). No other form of submission will be accepted.

Abstract Formatting:

- Avoid long titles (30 words max.).
- Abstracts must be clear, concise, & written in either Spanish or English. They are not to exceed 500 words (which will be automatically counted in the submission system).
- 3-5 keywords must be provided.
- If references must be cited, only those explicitly indicated in the body of the abstract may be included.

Do not leave it for the last minute!

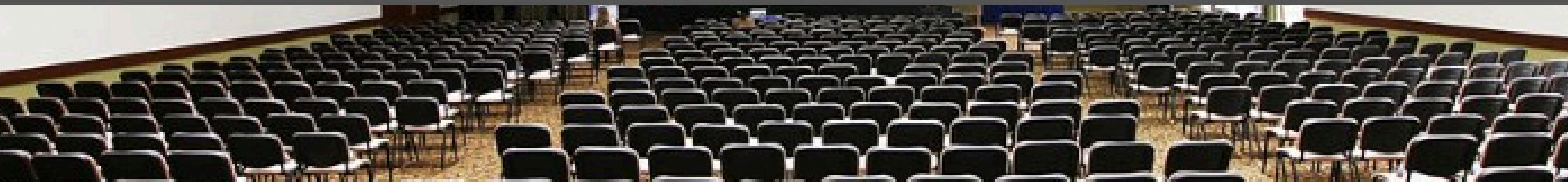

Definitions:

- **Members:** Participants having paid their annual SCG Membership fee for 2025.
- **Non-Members:** Participants that have no SCG Membership.
- **Undergraduate Students:** Participants that are currently registered as students in any GEO (or other fields) undergraduate (u/g) programs in Colombian or foreign universities.
- **Professionals:** Graduated professionals of any academic level who have already received their highest certificate (i.e., B.Sc., M.Sc., or Ph.D.).

The CCG2025 registration fee is non-cancelable & non-refundable, but transferable to other participants wishing to attend the Congress.

Registration Dates:

- **Early bird registration will start on April 1** & run until May 31.
- **Regular registration will start on June 1** & run until the last day of the Main Event.
- On-site registration will be permitted only for those who could not register online.

Payment Details:

Registration payments must be handled via our **online payment system** which will be up & running on the first day of registration on the Congress website.
